-strategies for new work

The work proposes multiple and alternative solutions to the existing urban environment.

The materials used must have a role within the structures or commerce of contemporary society.

The way the materials are combined and related must question or resist their familiar systems.

The work is simultaneously structure and arrangement.

All parts in the work must be active and relate to each other on multiple levels.

The work must have various entry points and be reversible. It is equally frontal and profile.

The work will be concluded at points of under- and overdevelopment.

There must be no superfluous parts in the work.

The work will provide open space next to areas of high concentration.

The work is temporary. It can be changed, moved or removed when it has become an integral part of its environment.

Systems established can be corrupted.
